Description

The two functions of the New Initial Report or Incident module are to create initial reports and to enter preliminary information about all incidents in ROSS.

The New Initial Report or Incident module allows a Dispatcher to quickly create an Initial Report or Incident. Dispatchers have the option to create an Initial Report to document an event that has not yet been determined to be an incident. An Initial Report may be promoted to an incident (*see Initial Report module information*). Dispatchers use this module to create internal incidents for organizations that they dispatch as well as external incidents for an affiliated dispatch office that does not use ROSS. The information required to create an incident is limited to the incident type, host, name, and location coordinates, all of which may be edited later (*see Incident module information*).



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All ROSS dispatch offices use this module to enter and create Incidents and to create Initial Reports at their option.

The New Initial Report or Incident module is related to the Tactical Aviation, Location, Incident, Initial Report, and Incident List modules as well as the entire ROSS Dispatch module.

Data Information:

Data Element	Data Definition
Reported By	The person or entity that reports the event to a dispatch center.
Description	Information about the New Incident or New Initial Report such as size, location, burning activity, etc.
Type	The nature of the New Initial Report or Incident (e.g., Fire - Wildfire, Fire – Prescribed, Flooding). <i>Required field.</i>
Incident Name	The name assigned to the New Incident. This field is <i>required for New Incident</i> and not captured for New Initial Report.
Incident Host	The organization with responsibility for the incident. <i>Required field for New Incident.</i>
Financial Codes	Financial codes to assign or create for the incident. If financial codes for the selected incident host have been created on the Organization screen they will be displayed. A 'Pick' button is enabled and opens a Select Financial Codes dialog. A 'New' button allows addition of ad hoc codes.
Office Reference	Used to assign an optional local reference number.
Location Name	The name of the vicinity reported to the Dispatch office. Used to name a New Initial Report.
Coordinate Type	Latitude/Longitude, PLSS, or UTM coordinates. <i>Required field.</i>
Location	The location information for the event. Regardless of the coordinate format entered, the data is automatically converted to, and may be displayed in, the other formats. Locations entered via the Location module may be selected. <i>Required field for New Incident.</i>



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Radio Frequencies	Displays the frequencies associated with the selected incident host organization.
Set Air Tactical <i>button</i>	Allows users to select one or more frequencies and identify them as air tactical frequencies for the new incident.
Documentation	Pertinent information or notes about a New Initial Report or Incident that the dispatcher wishes to capture.
Create Initial Report <i>button</i>	Saves the information to the Initial Report module.
Create Incident <i>button</i>	Saves the information entered to the Incident module.
Complex <i>checkbox</i>	Used to identify an incident as a complex. An incident must be identified as a complex when it is created. An existing non-complex incident may not be altered to make it a complex. Likewise, a complex incident may not be changed to make it not a complex. A complex may be any incident type except preposition .
