

Location Storage Codes screen allows you to designate specific areas for specialized storage. Typically, you will see Location Storage Codes defined for items that must be secured or refrigerated.


To view Location Storage Codes

- 1 On the **Application** menu, click to select **Warehouse Management**.
- 2 On the **Warehouse Management** menu, click to expand the **Warehouse Layout** menu, and then double-click **Location Storage Codes**.
- 3 On the **Location Storage Codes** screen, double-click the **Storage Code** of your choice.
- 4 To return to the **Location Storage Codes** screen, click on the **Location Storage Codes** dialog box 

To create a new Location Storage Code

- A On the **Warehouse Management** menu, click to expand the **Warehouse Layout** menu, and then double-click **Location Storage Codes**.
- B On the **Action** menu, click 
- C On the **Location Storage Codes** dialog box, complete the following text boxes, and then click 
 - Storage Code
 - Description.




To change a Location Storage Code

To delete a Location Storage Code

- A On the **Warehouse Management** menu, click to expand the **Warehouse Layout** menu, and then double-click **Location Storage Codes**.
- B On the **Location Storage Codes** screen, click the **Storage Code** of your choice, and then click .
- C On the **Confirmation** dialog box, click .
